Weekly Camp Dates and Themes

June 15–18: Taste the Rainbow - Get ready for a week bursting with color, creativity, and nonstop fun! During *Taste the Rainbow Week*, Camp Middletown transforms into a vibrant world of excitement as campers explore color through art projects, hands-on STEM discovery, and high-energy physical activities. It's a bright, playful week packed with imagination and fun from start to finish!

June 22–25: Deep Blue Discovery – Dive into an exciting Underwater Week at Camp Middletown! Campers become ocean scientists as they experiment with sink-or-float challenges, design mini submarines, and learn how sea creatures adapt to survive in different ocean zones. Creativity comes to life as campers build 3D sea creatures, paint underwater scenes, and work together on a colorful coral reef mural. Campers will also have a *whale* of a time playing Shark & Minnows and creating bioluminescent-inspired artwork.

June 29–July 2: America 250 – Past, Present, and Future – In celebration of America's 250th anniversary, campers will explore the people, ideas, inventions, and creativity that shaped our nation—and imagine what comes next. Through hands-on STEM challenges, art projects, cooperative games, and imaginative play, campers will journey from 1776 to the future, discovering how innovation, teamwork, and creativity continue to define America. Each day highlights a different era or concept, encouraging curiosity, problem-solving, and collaboration in a fun, age-appropriate way.

July 6–9: Step Right Up! – Circus Week transforms Camp Middletown into the *Greatest Camp on Earth!* Campers will explore the magic behind the big top through hands-on STEM challenges, creative art projects, and exciting physical activities inspired by acrobats, clowns, magicians, and performers. Along the way, campers build confidence, teamwork, coordination, and creativity—culminating in a camper-led circus showcase at the end of the week.

July 13–16: Green Guardians – Get ready to think green and take action! During Green Guardians Week at Camp Middletown, campers become environmental heroes as they explore recycling, sustainability, and caring for our planet through hands-on STEM projects, creative recycled art, and active outdoor games. Campers will learn how everyday choices can make a big difference while having fun, working together, and staying active. From building with reused materials to eco-challenges and clean-up games, this week encourages responsibility, creativity, and teamwork—helping campers become proud protectors of the Earth.

July 20–23: Heroes in Action – It's time to suit up and discover the hero within! During Heroes in Action Week at Camp Middletown, campers explore what it means to be a hero—real or imagined—through hands-on STEM challenges, creative art projects, and action-packed physical activities.
