Dear Resident,

The Middletown Township Sewer Authority (MTSA) has awarded a contract to McKenney Construction for the installation of a new pump station to replace our existing Paul pump station located at 46 Paul Lane. The work is being done as part of a long-term plan to maintain sewer capacity and update aging infrastructure within the Authorities' sanitary sewer collection system. The majority of the work will be located within the public right of way of Paul Lane and in the general vicinity of the existing Paul Lane pump station.

The contractor will be clearing the area and installing erosion and sediment controls during the week of May 18th. Actual construction of the pump station is tentatively scheduled to begin in mid-June and continue until completed, which is expected by September 31st. Hours of construction are weekdays, Monday through Friday, time starting at 7:00 am ending at 3:30 pm (may tentatively be extended due to unforeseen emergencies, or contractual obligations aren't being met).

You may notice the site where excavation is present; such will be temporarily restored on a daily basis whereas final restoration will not take place until the project is substantially completed. Temporary restoration may include; temporary construction fencing, paving, grading, backfilling, seed and topsoil restoration. Final restoration of the area will include a fence and landscaping around the pump station.
